ENGLISH TOY TERRIER (BLACK AND TAN) CLUB JUDGING LIST CRITERIA



A1 List

For persons who have previously been approved by The Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed, have completed their first appointment, and have the support of the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club.

A2 List

For person who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance of Kennel Club requirements, have been accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list, and have the support of the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club.

A3 List (Breed Specialists)

For persons whom the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club would support should they be offered an appointment to award CCs in the breed. Requirements:

- 1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club before approval to award CCs by the Kennel Club be granted.
- 2. To have judged a minimum of 25 classes of English Toy Terriers with at least 45 dogs present at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs.
- 3. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their 1st entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).
- 4. To have stewarded at 12 shows.
- 5. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice, and passed an examination and/or assessment.
- 6. To have attended a Conformation and Movement "Hands-on Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment.
- To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on The Points of The Dog.
- 8. To have attended a seminar delivered by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the Kennel Club examination on the Requirements of a Dog Show Judge.

A3 List (Non Specialists)

For persons whom the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club would support should they be offered an appointment to award CCs in the breed. Requirements include:

- 1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club before approval to award CCs by the Kennel Club be granted.
- To have judged a minimum of 25 classes of English Toy Terriers with at least 45 dogs present at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs.
- 3. To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed.
- 4. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment.
- 5. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their 1st entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).

B List (Breed Specialists)

For persons whom the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club would support to judge more than 3 classes of English Toy Terriers at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs.

- 1. To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club.
- 2. To have judged 9 classes of English Toy Terriers with at least 20 dogs present at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs.
- 3. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment.

B List (Non Specialists)

For persons whom the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club would support to judge more than 3 classes of English Toy Terriers at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs.

- 1. To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting in any one breed and have the support of the English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan) Club.
- To have judged 9 classes of English Toy Terriers with at least 20 dogs present at Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs.
- 3. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment.

C List (Breed Specialists & Non Specialists)

For aspirant judges who do not fit into the above categories but who have shown a distinct interest in the breed and have the support of The English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan Club).

Persons on this list may judge 3 classes or less of English Toy Terriers at Open Show level.

To be considered for this list, persons are expected:-

- 1. To have attended an English Toy Terrier Club Show
- 2. To have attended an English Toy Terrier Club Judging Seminar
